Portable engine fuelling system for marine use



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Preface

This is the second edition of CSA B306, *Portable engine fuelling system for marine use*. It supersedes the previous edition published in 1977 under the title *Portable Fuel Tanks for Marine Use*.

The changes to this edition include the following:

- addressed the influence that enhanced environmental and safety considerations have had on portable fuel container system designs;
- broadened the scope to include aftermarket components intended as part of a portable engine fuelling system;
- harmonized with international norms in test fuel specifications, material property verification, and safety marking practices; and
- reformatted the Standard to current CSA Group editorial requirements.

Nothing in this Standard should be considered in any way as indicating a measure of quality beyond compliance with the provisions it contains. It is designed to allow compliance of products which can exceed that specified in the provisions herein. In its preparation, full recognition has been given to possibilities of improvement through ingenuity of design. This Standard is subject to revision as further experience and investigation could show it is necessary and desirable.

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This Standard is considered suitable for use for conformity assessment within the stated scope of the Standard.

This Standard was prepared by the Technical Committee on Portable Fuel Tanks and Containers, under the jurisdiction of the Strategic Steering Committee on Fuels and Appliances, and has been formally approved by the Technical Committee.

This Standard has been developed in compliance with Standards Council of Canada requirements for National Standards of Canada. It has been published as a National Standard of Canada by CSA Group.

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
